Dunton Green & Riverhead

There have been a few thefts from cars in Riverhead, these have been reported to us and will be investigated accordingly. If anyone has any information, please contact 101.

We are still seeking information about the racist Graffiti in Dunton Green, this has been taking very seriously and we will continue to make any enquiries that might lead to the identity of the offender.

We are getting fewer reports of ASB at the recreation ground, but I will still monitor the area.

The road safety team have been out in Dunton Green doing speed checks, several drivers were stopped, and tickets were issued for speeding, and no seat belts.

Halstead, Knockholt & Badgers Mount

I am pleased to say that crime has been low this month, but as we are heading into the darker evenings, we cannot take things for granted. Please start checking your security and update or repair any thing that needs some TLC

We still have issues with people speeding through the villages, and I intend to be out with the speed gun as soon as I can.

Brasted, Chevening and Sundridge & Ide Hill

This month there has been a few reports of ASB in the villages, we have been fortunate enough to have CCTV footage, one of the offenders has been identified and will be dealt with accordingly. We would still like residents to report any ASB or suspicious behaviour so we can continue to work towards making the villages a happier and more peaceful place to live.

Westerham & Crockham Hill

ASB in the town has really reduced this month, due to the hard work of joint agencies and local PCSOs. We will continue to target any "Hotspot "area and deal with any issues accordingly. There has been a burglary in Crockham Hill so I will be paying passing attention to the area, but I would still like to ask residents to report any suspicious activity.
