- **45. Exclusion of Press & Public** It was resolved to exclude all members of the Public from discussions on Chipstead Lake after the presentation by the CLA

- **47. Declarations of interest or lobbying** Chairman declared an Interest in Item 53 (c) the fallen tree in Sailing Club Road as it is leaning against one of his trees

- **49. Questions from the Public** Flood Committee are proposing putting a storage shed for sandbags on PC **Mick Ryan** land between the Pavilion and the gate. They will submit a plan to the Council to approve before it is submitted for planning consent.
- 50. Open Spaces
- a) **Open Space Inspection** Cllr de Turbeville requested the bench in Bessel Green is moved to be facing more of the Green
- b) **Playground Inspection** Cllr Weavers commented on how popular the playground is with everyone.
- c) **Holmesdale Anglers** Chris Becker & Mick Cove presented the Club's plans to open access to the fishing lake to "social members". Membership would give pedestrian access to all the land they own and the right to fish at the ponds at Montreal Park
- d) **Football Club** The Football Club are unwilling to pay any rent on the Recreation Ground as they have been unable to use it. The Council has incurred maintenance costs of around £4000 with no rent received. The Council agreed that half the rent would be waived for April and that the Clerk should invoice the other half to the Club. The Council requested Alan Black comes to the next meeting to update on his assessment of the drainage and proposals as to what recompense may be sought from Bourne.
- **51. Footpath Matters** Clerk had received a volunteer to adopt a footpath. The allocation of footpaths normally takes place in May and matter will be discussed then. Cllr de Turbeville suggested utilising the help of the monthly Parish Walk
- 52. Highway Matters
- a) **Traffic control in Chipstead** 20 mph limit it was resolved to implement the 20mph limit despite concerns raised about being able to enforce it. It was felt that it would be beneficial to have the
