202 Minutes of Previous Meeting

The minutes of the meeting held on 9th March 2015 were agreed will be signed subject to appendix 3 being circulated and agreed.

203 Questions from the Public

There was concern about the cobble stones in Chipstead High Street. The Chairman said it was a matter that needed to be taken up with Sevenoaks District Council.

There was also concern about the pot holes appearing along Chevening Road, in particular to the entrance to Chevening School car park. The Clerk said that a report has been put in to KCC Highways.

There was a question as to when the kerb stones near Chevening School would be painted white. The Clerk Clerk undertook to ask Kent Highways again when this would be progressed.

204 Open Spaces Matters

a) Open Spaces Inspections

Cllr Eastwood enquired when the grass was going to be cut at the recreation ground. The Clerk will ask MDH Horticultural.

b) Playground Inspections

c) Playground Opening

d) Pitch Drainage

The Chairman updated the Council – planning guidance has now been applied for from Sevenoaks District Council. Alan Black is to complete an application form for a grant paying for the project. The Clerk is to provide a copy of the Council's insurance Policy to Alan, this has now been actioned.

e) Quote for Posts and Gate for Recreational Ground

The Clerk updated the Council on a quote received from W Hardy Builders Ltd in the sum of £1,116.00 incl Vat for 12 Oak Bollards to be erected around the recreational Ground, together with a collapsible post. Cllr Clark asked if the football club could also make a donation. The Chairman to enquire.

206 Highway Matters

a) Issues raised with KCC

Cllr Metcalf reported that cars seemed to be more mindful about parking on the grass verge around Bessels Green.

b) 'No Parking Sign' on Bessel's Green

The Clerk updated the Council that to erect the posts on the green outside the King's Head at Bessel's Green is going the cost £60 plus vat, a quote received from W Hardy Builders Ltd. The Clerk is going to continue with the research into the actual sign to go onto the posts, as the dimensions required have not yet been found.

207 Correspondence Received and General Issues

a) Flood Protection

The Chairman updated the Council that the drainage provisions in the Coombe Bank area had been dammed by a local game keeper enabling ducks to be kept. KCC, who is now responsible for this area will write a letter to the owner of this area, asking them to remove the dam.

b) Lamp Post damage at Home Farm

The Chairman updated the Council that all permissions have been applied for and that he was waiting on the insurance company of the policy holder to confirm whether or not they will pay for the damage.

c) Porch 9-11 Chipstead High Street

Nothing to update, but the Chairman has noticed that the rain has washed off white markings. The Clerk to get an update from KCC.

d) Darent Valley Landscape Partnership

Cllr Metcalf informed the Council of the report she had circulated. She said that if she is needed to, she is willing to stay a contact on this after she has left the Council. The Chairman said that if she was willing to stay a contact then the Council would be grateful for that to be the case.

e) War Memorials Trust

Cllr Weavers updated the Council – the Trust was happy to give us some kind of a grant, however, the Council will also have to contribute to the funding awarded.

f) <u>Family Fun Day</u>

The Chairman reported that Cllr Dalton has said she has the organisation of this in hand.

g) <u>Circus</u>

Cllr Metcalf reported on the letter she had circulated and that the circus could operate on Chipstead Common as a suitable site. She informed the Council that the circus organisers would visit the site to check its suitability first. The Clerk to organise this.

h) Bench request for Burial Ground

It was **RESOLVED** by the Council, that a bench could be installed in the burial ground at the cost of the Parishioner wishing to install it.

The Pensions Regulator

The Chairman informed the Council that he would register with the Pensions Regulator by end of April, the due date.

j) Volunteer Transport Group Donation

It was **RESOLVED** by the Council, that a donation of £100 could be given to Volunteer Transport Group.
